



Chaplin's Comments

Dear Brother Knights,

Last month, I wrote an article about some practical points on Confession and this month I would like to add a few more.

One of the incentives for using the Sacrament of Confession often and regularly is a kind of leveling-up effect which I preach about in my homilies. Here is the explanation.

Let's say for example, I have committed a grave or mortal sin (they are the same thing) and as a result of which, I have destroyed Sanctifying Grace in my soul. In last month's article, I talked about the three conditions necessary for an act, word, or thought to be a mortal sin. Mortal sin places my soul in a state in which I am not able to present myself for Holy Communion—that is, that I am not allowed to receive the Holy Eucharist until I go to Confession, and repair the damage that has been done by the mortal sin. So, mortal sin prohibits me from receiving Holy Communion. We also call this state "failing to be in a state of grace." Once I have gone to Confession and received absolution from the Priest, my Sanctifying Grace returns to my soul and I am now in a state of grace, and able (permitted) to receive Holy Communion. Further, after having gone to Confession, I am now placed back in complete union with God once again. That's something else that is a result from committing a mortal sin, I separate myself from God completely. Recall that if I were to die in this state, there is a strong likelihood that I would go to Hell. Thank God for the repeatable sacrament of Confession!

By the way, a simple understanding of Sanctifying Grace is divine life. We live continuously in this state until we fall into sin. Grace is divine life and we need divine life if we expect to live in Heaven. Divine Life in its totality is bestowed upon us in baptism. Ever since baptism, we live in covenant relationship with God.

Now to the point at hand, every single time I go Confession, my soul receives back all the grace that it lost, AND every single time I go to Confession, my soul's capacity to receive grace increases or grows, and my soul is filled to that new maximum level! So, I'm growing in my capacity to receive grace whenever I go to Confession, and receiving more and more grace (divine life).

There's still more good news for those of us who believe they do not commit any mortal sins but are aware of the precept of the Church that obligates us to go to Confession at least once per year under the pain of mortal sin (I talked about this in my previous article). Even if we don't have mortal sins to confess, we can still bring venial sins (lesser sins) to confession and receive absolution for them, and our souls experience this same leveling-up effect that I have been talking about.

If you have been waiting for a while for the right time to return to Confession, I would say do not wait any longer. Go online, and type in *How to go to Confession* and/or *Examination of Conscience* into your search engine and get prepared for receiving the mercy of God in Confession...and leveling-up too! As I stated in last month's article, an Examination of Conscience is a list of questions relative to the Ten Commandments and the Precepts of the Church, which we use to prepare for Confession (making lists makes the confession go faster).




2023 Fr. Saylor Memorial Mass

Party favors will be provided on this night along with Pizzas being delivered around 11pm from Bellas Pizza.


