



PGK, FDD Ron Fix (1940-2023) Editor Emeritus

Roland (Ron) Fix was born June 6th, 1940. Over the next 83 years he had many adventures and accomplishments. But here we will focus on his Knights of Columbus achievements and particularly of his leadership of the Knight Notes of Council #3774 Allen Park. He made it arguably the finest Knights of Columbus Newsletter in the State of Michigan.

Ron joined the Knights in 1974 and managed to remain active during the 70's despite a heavy work load during his 35 years at Ford as well as assisting his wife Darlene raise their three children, Linda, Tom and Scott. As the 80's went on and his sons grew, he and they, became active in the Columbian Squires, with Ron serving as the Chief Counselor. Ron took on progressively more important offices in the Fr Saylor Council culminating in serving as Grand Knight from 1991 through 1993. After this, he remained active serving as District Deputy and was our Lecturer for many

years. His activity peaked when he served on the committee that raised the funds to erect a "Monument To The Unborn" in the St Frances Cabrini Memorial Garden in November 2000 and the February 7th 2004 celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the Fr Saylor Council. But Ron's most lasting impression on the Fr Saylor Council was the transformation he effected on the Council newsletter, The Knight Notes.

In 2010 Ron joined the group that produced the Knight Notes. When the Knight Notes was first published back in August of 1954, it was a pasted up black and white copy, mostly comprised of type written text, rarely interspersed with a photo, copied by a printer and mailed to the membership. Ron took over as the "Layout" person and slowly began the quiet transformation of what the Knight Notes is today. In 2012, while the newsletter grew in size the artwork and text was sent to the printer in digital format. As the Council established an online presence, a color copy of the Knight Notes was produced. Over time, Ron developed a library of digital text and images making it easier for writers to generate copy. Eventually, a Knight Notes committee was formed of which Ron remained the "Layout" person and really functioned as the Editor. By 2016, the Knight Notes evolved into a 12 page color electronic copy that was emailed to members under Ron's leadership. That same process is used today. Ron brought the Fr. Saylor Council into the 21st century without most of us even realizing it.

It was my pleasure to serve for 13 years as the "Writer" under Ron Fix as my "Editor". In over 50 years as an author, scientist, writer and monthly newsletter publisher, I have never had an Editor whom I had greater affection for.

Ron will be forever remembered as Editor Emeritus of the Knight Notes.

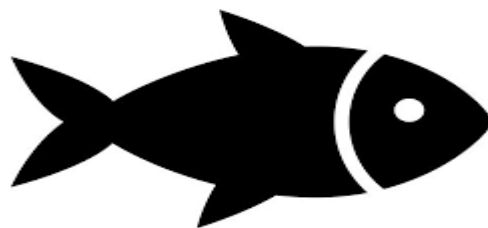
Joe's Soup Corner

There will be four rounds of 25 songs per round for a total of 100 songs, music will vary from the 50's on up.

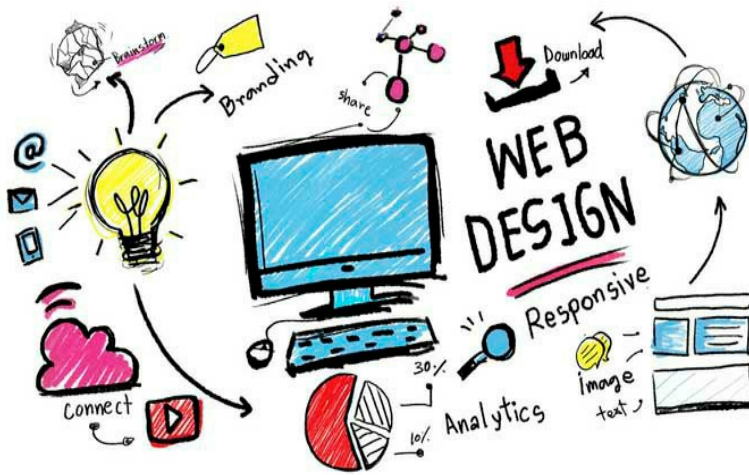
You will earn points for naming the group/artist and for knowing the song titles.
