As a whole March was an excellent month for Fr. Saylor. Every weekend we had something going on and each event was a great success. Thank you all for making Our Council the best in Michigan.

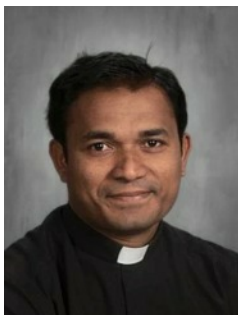

## Chaplain's Comments



**Fr. Johnson**

### **A LITTLE BIT ABOUT OUR CHAPLIN FR. JOHNSON PRADEEP, SAC**

Fr. Johnson is a member of the International Religious Order, the Society of the Catholic Apostolate (SAC), known by most as the Pallotines, which was founded in 1835 by the Italian priest, St. Vincent Pallotti. Fr. Johnson is among a number of Pallotine priests who have been assigned to the Archdiocese of Detroit and are currently serving in several parishes (St. Pius, Southgate & St. Vincent Pallotti, Wyandotte) as well as in other states throughout the country.

Fr. Johnson was raised in a close knit, devout Catholic family of five children of which he is the second eldest Son. He has three brothers and one sister. After being actively involved in various parish ministries/activities in his home parish, he responded to God's call to the priesthood. He began his formation at the age of sixteen and after thirteen years of intense priestly formation, he was ordained a priest on May 10, 2018 at Queen of Heaven Church in the Archdiocese of Pondicherry, India.

Fr. Johnson felt called to be a Pallotine priest because he was moved by the spirit and motto of St. Vincent Pallotti, "Love of God Urges Us On", (2Cor.5:14), and chooses to live these ideals. After his ordination, he served as an Assistant Novice Master in a local seminary in India by assisting in the formation of other young men to be good followers of Jesus and members of the Pallotine Society. Fr. Johnson was later appointed in 2020 as an Assistant Parish Priest in the Diocese of Coimbatore, India.

He is currently carrying out his first overseas assignment by continuing his priestly ministry in the Archdiocese of Detroit and specifically at St. Frances Cabrini, St. Mary Magdalen and St. Andrew & Benedict.
