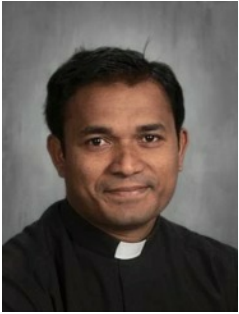

On April 8, 2024, the United States experienced a remarkable event that captivated people of all ages, as individuals donned various glasses to witness it. Such occurrences are rare and hold significance beyond the ordinary. The last Total Solar Eclipse in Michigan

happened on June 30, 1954, making this recent event particularly special. While solar eclipses happen every few years, a total eclipse in a specific location is much rarer, occurring only once every hundred years, according to NASA reports. During a total eclipse, the moon aligns almost perfectly with the sun, obscuring its entire disk for a few precious minutes, a phenomenon known as totality. This eclipse's path of totality, stretching 115 miles wide, traversed three states in Mexico, 15 U.S. states, and four states in southeast Canada.

Beyond its astronomical marvel, the eclipse offers a profound lesson, reflecting on our perspectives on life and faith. Just as a celestial event can alter our perception of the sun and moon, the differing viewpoints prevalent in our world—be it religion, politics, or other realms—shape our understanding.

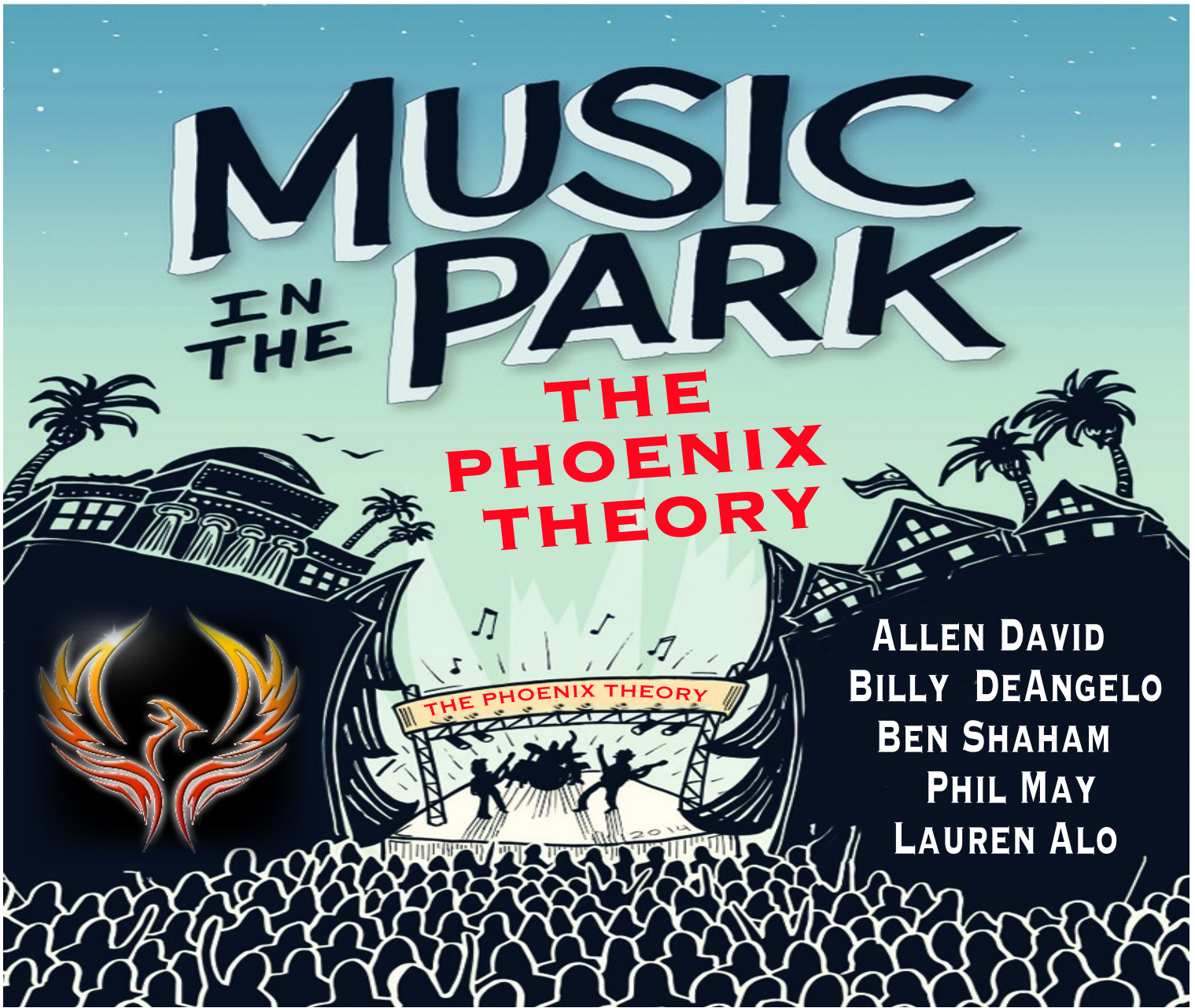


Thursday Golf

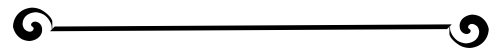

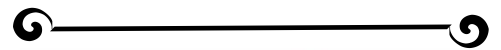
